- 5. Gold recipients please bring your Girl Scout Gold project board to display. This can be the same project board that you will be using at the Council event.

LEADER INFORMATION

If you have anyone who is being honored/recognized that can't attend, please let us know so we can update the ceremony. They will still be honored/recognized in the program.
- 2. Please arrive around 3:30pm to receive instructions regarding the event.
- 3. Please read through the items to do before the event and at the event so you are prepared.
- 4. We always need additional hands after the event so please provide additional volunteers for refreshments and cleanup if possible. If you also have a Cadette or higher level Girl Scout who would like to help, we would love to have them.

BRONZE

Prior to the event:

- We will make arrangements for you to sign the certificates
- Purchase the Bronze Award Pins (Troop provided)
- Practice the Girl Scout Handshake with your troop
- The Girl Scouts will present their project prior to being recognized. Please split the project description into 1-2 sentences that each girl can say to describe the project.
- We suggest that you type up each person's lines so they can read them at the event.
- Please practice with your troop to ensure they are comfortable with their lines.

At the event:

- The leaders and Girl Scouts will be called up to the stage to present their project prior to being recognized.
- Make sure everyone has their papers (lines) for the day and seat them/line them up in speaking order.
- As practiced, the Girl Scouts will share their project with the audience.
- We will then ask you to call each Girl Scout's name and present them with their Bronze award. The primary accomplishment should be honored at the troop level, however you may present the Bronze pin that you have purchased at this time if you would like.

SILVER

GOLD

Prior to the event:

- As the leader you will be there to present their pin.

10 Year

Prior to the event:

- Please bring a 10-year pin for your Girl Scout.
- As the leader, you will present their pin.

Graduating Seniors

Prior to the event:
